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Интерактивный урок-конкурс «Агата Кристи-королева детектива»

Аннотация. В статье представлен опыт проведения интерактивного урока-конкурса среди 9-11 классов, посвященный творчеству английской писательницы Агата Кристи. Рассмотрены различные типы упражнений, такие, как закончить предложение, выбрать правильный вариант ответа, соотнести картинку и название, заполнить пропуски, расставить предложения в правильном порядке, ответить на вопросы.

Интерактивная разработка была создана с помощью сервиса Wizer.me. Сервис позволяет включить автоматическую проверку и оценивание ответов, а также предусмотрена возможность обратной связи по заданиям с развернутыми ответами, как например, монологическое высказывание или письменное рассуждение.

Ключевые слова: английская литература, урок-конкурс, интерактивная разработка, онлайн сервис, типы заданий.

Цель урока-конкурса - самоконтроль и обобщение знаний обучающихся по теме «Агата Кристи - королева детектива».

A Tricky Password

As a club member comes to the door, the security officer says, "Twelve". She replies, "Six" and gets in. Another member comes to the door. The security officer says, "Six" and the man replies, "Three" and gets in. Matt thinks that he understands the pattern and walks up to the door. The security officer says, "Ten" and Matt replies, "Five" but the security guard doesn't let him in. What's the password?

(Answer: Matt was supposed to say the number of letters in the word told to him by the security guard. The word "twelve" has six letters, the word "six" has three. "Ten" has three letters, so the password would have been "Three".)

The Traveling Salesman

Joe Nesbo, a travelling salesman, was staying at a hotel for business. He was having a dinner meeting that night, so he decided to take a nap in the middle of the afternoon. He was awakened by a knock at the door, and then a man walked in. "Oh my, I'm terribly sorry, this isn't my room. Please, pardon the intrusion." The man calmly backed out and left. Nesbo got up and locked the door – something he forgot to do before his nap – and lay back down on the bed. But then he shot up in bed and called the lobby to tell them there was a burglar on the prowl. What made Nesbo think that?

(Answer: If the man thought it was his room, he wouldn't have knocked)
